



Das vorliegende Libretto wurde aber vermutlich anlässlich einer späteren Aufführung (1700?-1773) im Jahr 1749 gedruckt. Libretto-Hefte dieser Art wurden zu Opern- oder Oratorienaufführungen im Theater verkauft und ermöglichten dem Publikum das Mitlesen des gesungenen Textes.





SONG.


How beautiful are the Feet of them that preach the Gospel of Peace, and bring glad Tidings of good Things.

Thou shalt break them with a Rod of Iron, thou shalt dash them in pieces like a Potter's Vessel.


CHORUS.

SONG.



CHORUS.



Bleffing and Honour, Glory and Power be unto him that fitteth upon the Throne, and unto the Lamb, for ever and ever. Amen.




